### Director's Message

Dear Parents,

We are getting to that stage of the year when the new Admissions process begins for the next academic year, 2021-22. As you will know, applications opened last October for parents who have siblings currently in the school and we have just been undertaking the testing of those students. The OpenApply applications process will open on 17th January, when parents who do not have a child currently in the school can apply for places at QAD. In practice, we do not have many places in the Primary School as most of the Grades are already full, but it is likely that some places will become available in the course of the year, as parents move overseas etc. and that is why we maintain a waiting list. There are places available in the EEC and in most Grades in the Senior School. If you know parents who are looking for spaces in these Grades, please do encourage them to apply – the earlier the better.

Yesterday, we participated in the Virtual Fair "Discover PUE", where parents could join a virtual fair and have the chance to engage with any of the schools in the Qatar Foundation. This was a very well organized event, run by the PUE Communications Department and I was impressed by the amount of effort and professionalism which went into it. We had Admissions and Admin staff available from 10.00 am to 6.00 pm to answer any questions which prospective parents might have and there was also the opportunity for parents to receive digital documents about the school to read later. There were a number of webinars throughout the day and it was good to see some of our students participating in the session on THIMUN. Four of our recent Alumnae spoke about their time at QAD in the final session of the day, explaining just how much they got from studying at the school. I am very grateful to the students, Alumnae and staff who participated on the day and, in particular, Thuraya Abulkhair our PR Officer and Ghada Abdelkarim our Admissions Assistant, for all their work in the build up to the event and on the day.

لقد وصلنا إلى موعد بدء عمليّة القبول والتّسجيل للعام الدراسيّ القادم 2021 – 2022. كما تعلمون، فقد فتح باب التّسجيل في شهر أكتوبر الماضي لمن لديهم أشقّاء حاليًا في المدرسة ، وقد قمنا للتّو باختبار هؤلاء الطلاب.

سيفتح باب تقديم الطّلبات في 17 يناير الجاري حيث يمكن لأولياء الأمور الذين ليس لديهم أطفال في المدرسة حاليًا بالتّقديم لأطفالهم.

## Principal's Message

Dear Parents,

Live registration will be shared with you on Sunday 17th for After School Activities options, so look out for that!

We have approached some families to support and agree to, our Reading Intervention initiative for students. As Covid guidance has insisted that we operate at 50% capacity right now in a Blended programme, some opportunities to read together have been lost. This is the school's way of supplementing Arabic and English reading for those students who we need to capture. So please sign up if you have been approached by our team. It will be a 10-week reading booster group, delivered by our Arabic speaking team and our English speaking team. We will teach reading using Levelled Literacy books. Teachers will lead a group of students, maximum 4, through mini lessons, 30 minutes long, twice a week after school. On the other days the students may choose an ASA as mentioned.

I would like to thank the huge amount of our staff who signed up to support this After School Reading initiative. The response has been amazing and I am truly grateful for their unwavering efforts to do the best for our QAD children.

The MAP assessment cycle has come around again and we plan to administer a 'full' MAP assessment this time, not the shorter 'Screener' students took back in October. This will provide yourselves and the Teacher a detailed progress report for your child. It will show strengths and areas for development for your child to work on next. From a whole school perspective, it compares the data to last year at this time and we can analyze trends and compare ourselves to the suggested 'norm'. This data helps inform School Improvement and myself and my team review our learning provision. More details to follow on this from our Curriculum Coordinators.

We have had a busy week screening QAD families for Admissions to some Grades. On Sunday 17th January OPEN APPLY goes live for other applicants and Grade levels, so please look out for that and tell any interested families. Linked to this, my team and I have been working closely with PUE on supporting parent expectations when they join QAD. I am pleased to say we have developed a Parents as Partners Agreement that, once verified will form part of the Admissions process. More to come on this.
