



## Director's Message

### Dear Parents,

The new term has seen a very small number of students with positive test results for Covid-19. However, either the students had not been to school this term, before they tested positive, or had not been here in the preceding nine days before they were infected, which means that there have been no students or staff who have been close contacts. That has meant that we have not had to ask any classes to go into quarantine this term, so that all student have been able to come to school as normal. That is very good news and I do want to thank you all for being very vigilant to ensure that you are not sending any children to school, if there is any possibility that they might have been in contact with a positive case. In this way we can keep our community safe.

One or two parents have contacted the school to ask about the arrangements for their children coming to school, if the family are planning to go to Saudi Arabia for the weekend, now that the land border is open. The government press release says that travelling to Saudi Arabia by car is no different from travelling by air, so that anyone going to Saudi Arabia will need to quarantine for seven days in an approved quarantine hotel, on their return to Qatar. In that context, if any family does go to Saudi Arabia, the children will be able to study online during the required seven days' quarantine period and can then return to school in person on the completion of the quarantine. أولياء الأمور الكرام،

لقد تم تسجيل عدد من حالات كوفيد-19 الإيجابية لبعض طلّابنا خلال الفصل الدّراسي الجديد، ومع ذلك ، فإمّا أنّ الطّلاب لم يحضروا إلى المدرسة هذا الفصل، قبل أن تكون نتيجة اختبارهم إيجابية، أو لم يكونوا هنا في الأيام التسعة السابقة قبل الإصابة ممّا يعني أنه لم يكن هناك طلاّب أو موظّفين كانوا على اتصال وثيق بهم، لذلك لم يتعيّن علينا أن نظلب من أي الفصول الدخول في الحجر الصحي خلال الفصل الدّراسي الحالي كي يتمكن جميع الطلاب من القدوم إلى المدرسة كالمعتاد. هذه أخبار جيدة جدًا وأودّ أن أشكركم جميعًا على توخّي الحذر الشديد و عدم إرسال أي طفل إلى المدرسة إذا كان هناك أي احتمال أنه ربما كان على اتصال وثيق بحالة إيجابية. بهذه الطريقة، يمكننا الحفاظ على أمن وسلامة مجتمعنا.

لقد اتّصل بنا عدد من أولياء الأمور للاستفسار عن الترتيبات الخاصة بقدوم أطفالهم إلى المدرسة ، في حال كانو ا يخطّطون للذهاب إلى المملكة العربية السعودية في عطلة نهاية الأسبوع ذلك بعد أن تم فتح الحدود البرية، فكما تعلمون أنّ ما جاء في البيان الصّحفي الحكوميّ أينصّ على أنّ السفر إلى المملكة العربية السعودية بالسّيارة لا يختلف عن السّفر لها جواً ، لذا سيحتاج أي شخص يسافر إلى المملكة العربية السعودية إلى الحجر الصحي لمدة سبعة أيام في فندق معتمد عند عودته إلى قطر. في هذا السياق، سيتمكن الأطفال من الدّراسة عبر الإنترنت خلال فترة الحجر الصحي والذي يستغرق سبعة أيام ، ويمكنهم بعد ذلك العودة إلى المدرسة شخصيًا عند الانتهاء من الحجر الصحي. إذا كانت لديكم أي أسئلة أو استفسارات، يرجى الاتصال بأحد أعضاء الإدارة في المدرسة الثانوية أو المدرسة الابتدائية.

There was a meeting for all Grade 10 students and their parents on Monday to answer any questions or inquire about educational pathways for certain post secondary degrees. It was a very busy session with many students and parents accessing the expertise of our Lead Teachers in the subject departments. With the recent re-establishment of relations within the GCC it is a wonderful time for family members to travel to meet with other family in neighbouring countries. The removal of barriers allows easy travel via SUV that had been more difficult in recent years. However, some parents had wondered if this would result in students travelling but not quarantining. This led us to investigate government policy. The government press release from last week states that travelling to Saudi Arabia by car is no different from travelling by air. Anyone going to Saudi Arabia will need to quarantine in a hotel in Doha for 7 days, upon their return. Once the students have completed that quarantine period (during which they can study online), they will be able to come to school.
